

Huelo Point Flower Farm

Aloha and Greetings from Maui, the Valley Isle...

The area you will be staying in is called Huelo (hu-way'-low), located on Maui's rugged North Shore, an area of incomparable natural beauty and splendor. The valley we are located in is surrounded by streams, waterfalls, natural pools and lush countryside.

Our property is a two-acre tropical garden land. You are welcome to indulge in any of the organic fruits or veggies growing here. Your accommodations include a private hot tub. You will also have access to our large natural rock swimming pool.

Driving time between Kahului and Huelo is 35-45 minutes. As there are not any stores or restaurants in Huelo, you might like to purchase a few things before you drive out. In Kahului, where the airport is, you'll find stores like Costco, Wal-Mart, K-Mart, and Safeway Grocery. A bit closer to us, in the town of Paia, there is a natural foods grocery called Mana (closes at 8:30pm) and a liquor store called The Wine Corner.

Please call or e-mail us before you leave on your vacation to let us know what time you plan on arriving. Check in time is any time after 3:00pm.

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DIRECTIONS: From Kahului or the airport, just look for signs directing you toward Hana. Take the Hana Highway (#36) through the town of Paia and along the North Shore. There are green roadside mile markers which start at "0" in Kahului. They "turn over" after mile 16 and start again at "0" after the intersection of Highway #365 (Kaupakalua Rd.). Continue on the Hana Highway a few miles until you see the large yellow sign which says, "Narrow Winding Road Next 30 Miles"; this is where you start the true Hana Highway of legend, with its many curves. Go less than a mile (8/10 of a mile) past that sign and look on the left for the Door of Faith Road turn-out, a long, wide pull-out with many mailboxes, a green bus shelter, and a pay phone. Again the road is on your left (the ocean side) and is between mile markers 3 and 4. Check your odometer when you turn down this road. It is a narrow country road, so please go **SLOWLY** and carefully at all times (**15 mph or less** especially if you see people or horses at the side, or if it's dusty), and just enjoy the views on the way down. You'll pass two churches and when you've traveled 0.5 miles and see a sign that reads "Drive Slow/ Children Playing" and a "Slow 15 mph" sign, **turn left**. The road becomes quite bumpy at this point. At 0.9 miles there is a sharp left curve in the road and at 1.0 miles there is a sharp right curve in the road. Finally at 1.1 miles **turn left**. The second driveway on the right is the entrance to the property and is clearly marked with two white gate pillars topped with red tile and the Huelo Point Flower Farm sign.

Please park anywhere in front of the garage doors. Upon arrival please check in at the office. If we are not here when you arrive please make yourself at home and we'll see you around sunset.

- The Main House is past the office and the pool and down the gravel path on the left.
- The Guest House is down the gravel path on the right side of the pool.
- The Carriage House is upstairs, above the garage.
- The Gazebo Cottage is straight through the wooden gate, past the pool, and on the left at the edge of the cliff.
